The survey concentrated on work and working life in the Baltic countries. Questions regarding the working community, nature of the work, wages, work history, family life, leisure habits, and social participation were asked. In addition, respondents were asked about their values and opinions, voting patterns, views on political and economic matters, and a range of background variables. For details, please refer to the codebook.

An outline of the type of sample and the main data collection methods used

A multi-stage random sampling procedure was employed. The target population consisted of persons aged 15 years or more living in Latvia and Lithuania, and persons aged 18-65 years living in Estonia. The sample sizes were around 1,500.

Data collection was done through face-to-face interviews.
